2NT is a puppet to 3♣, to show a weak hand that wants to play a suit lower than the opening or a game force with 4-c oM.

3-level bids (non jumps): "Invitational", promises some values

Cuebid: Stopper ask without 4-c oM

Other bids: "Natural"

#### [Supplementary note 7] – Special doubles and redoubles

3-card support doubles and redoubles

Played up to (and including) 2M after 1 ◆/▼-1M. Not obligatory but we may double with 11 balanced and 4333.

#### Maximum Overcall Doubles

Double is invitational after we are in 2M after a raise (for example) 1M-2M when oppenents bid 3M-1 independently if they raise each other or if it's their side's first bid. Over lower bids, dbl is for penalty.
